## **General Discussion Items**

- Director's updates (Mr. Baragas)
  - Movement 4 complete, and touching up for Saturday (repeat, refine, adjustments)
  - Kids are working hard and doing well
  - Props parents, please voice concerns re: any issues
    - Weight of props, time to set up props not addressed when the design of the props occurred
    - Many complaints from parents not heard
    - Parents want understanding of how props are created (idea, decisions, development)
    - If 8 adults are not available, it is a VERY difficult task to load the props
    - If feedback is not wanted, then don't ask (just deal with it is not an answer)
    - Recommendation send out email for additional help when needed
    - Parents feel that if feedback is not heard, then why give it
  - Mr Baragas signed on as band director at Travis because of the potential of the program and his vision
    - Show design is a better product for future push
    - Biggest props, hardest show this year
    - Challenging the kids has been a focus this year, in an effort to move the band & guard to the next level
    - Growth is uncomfortable, but normal
    - Props was difficult, but with repetition the use of props has become better
    - Tops for props are not needed for rehearsals
    - Mr Baragas apologized if parents feel that he did not hear the issue
    - Design for next year's show starts as soon as marching season ends; design team comes up with
      - Working concepts
      - Music
      - Show theme
      - Props are designed through a visual coordinator (material, color, size, etc)
        - Movement = more points in contests
      - Cost \$30k design team, \$27,500 props
      - Forecast prop use 5-6yrs
    - Total numbers of kids is provided to drill writers in May
      - The show is developed with alternates planned for things like illness, failing grades, injury
      - This year, the alternates march the show/drill during games for the practice
      - The kids get to learn drill, choreography, music as alternates; some move props
      - Comment the alternates marching is a good perception of the kids learning the drill and they grow

    - Cost was about \$700-800
    - It will be used for the rest of the season
  - Winter Ball/PJ Party
    - Made decision to have this event
    - Date is 12/14/24
